Changes in Required WIC Formulas

As of April 30, 2007, Nestlé will stop making the formulas shown below.



Good Start Essentials

Good Start 2 Essentials

NAN™ DHA & ARA

Production of Nestlé GOOD START ESSENTIALS, GOOD START 2 ESSENTIALS, and NAN DHA & ARA will be discontinued in April 2007. The last shipments of these Nestlé products are planned for April 30, 2007. For this reason, vendors will no longer be required to carry Nestlé GOOD START ESSENTIALS and Nestlé NAN infant formulas. The new formula minimum inventory requirements are listed below.

New Minimum Inventory Requirements for Infant Formula Effective May 1, 2007

Effective May 1, the minimum inventory requirements for formula will change. The new required amounts of formula will be:

- Nestlé GOOD START SUPREME DHA & ARA - 13 oz. **concentrated liquid** 24 cans
- Nestlé GOOD START SUPREME DHA & ARA - 12 oz. **powder** 12 cans
- Nestlé GOOD START SUPREME SOY DHA & ARA - 12.9 oz. **powder** 6 cans



Effective May 1, stores are no longer required to carry a minimum amount of Nestlé GOOD START ESSENTIALS powder or Nestlé NAN DHA & ARA powder.

Effective June 1, 2007, NIDO canned dry whole milk will be allowed to be purchased with WIC checks **only when specified on the front of the check**. Can sizes allowed will be 1.98 lb (900 g) and 14.1 oz (400 g).

Other Food Eligibility Changes Effective June 1, 2007

The following are new food products and other changes:

- Juicy Juice Harvest Surprise is NOT eligible.
- Cracker Cuts, any brand, are NOT eligible.
- Canned light tuna, 6 oz. can or larger. Plain, water, spring water, or oil packed. NO pouches. NO white or albacore. NO olive oil, lemon, flavored, gourmet, or added ingredients. NO low or less sodium.
